STAY ALERT, Stay informed, be involved!

MRPEA continues to make progress as we strive to develop an active grassroots network. As president, it is my goal to see our membership increase and to include members who are currently employed. This group is most vulnerable to any proposed changes to PERS. Please help me encourage current employees to become a part of our group so that they will have a voice.

Another goal is the educating and training of the district directors to keep the members in their districts informed. Communications Committee Chair and District Director Wynona Winfield is developing a guide



for district directors which will be in place soon. We had our third Legislative Day at the Capitol in February, which is helping to increase awareness of MRPEA with the legislature. Next year's event is already scheduled for Thursday, January 17, 2019, from 8:30 AM - 11:00 AM, and we encourage as many of you to attend as possible.

While there was no negative legislation introduced this session involving PERS, the legislature continues to erode state government with budget cuts and fewer employees while continuing to support large tax breaks for big business. It is our understanding that if another employer contribution is required by PERS in the coming year, the legislature does not intend to fund it even though it is their responsibility, further burden agencies. The legislature is also on record as saying that, unlike the monthly benefit, the annual Cost of Living Adjustment is NOT an entitlement. Discussions have been held in regard to making changes to it, including suspending the COLA for several years.

Mike Larsen continues to do an outstanding job as networking chair. We have a very good group of partner organizations whose members are also members of PERS. These groups are well-organized and established in working with the legislature and committed to working with MRPEA to advocate against any changes to PERS benefits.

MRPEA is very fortunate to have employed Emily Pote as our executive director. Emily is energetic, enthusiastic, already very knowledgeable about the mission of PERS, and is a tremendous asset to our organization. Judy Clark has recently accepted the position of Secretary following the resignation of Bob Rhoads citing other commitments. Bob did an outstanding job for two years, and we appreciate his service.

Finally, the new executive director of PERS has been announced. Ray Higgins will take over for Pat Robertson effective July 1. We will be watching this transition and hope to have more information soon.
